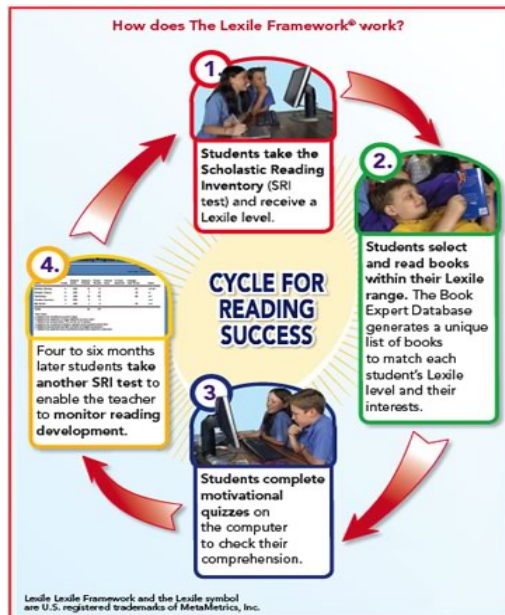


Middle Primary Program

The middle primary team of year four and five are continually working towards improving learning and interest for students. This involves negotiated/shared planning of curriculum and the exchange of ideas. We seek to find a 'happy medium' between effective traditional methodology and innovative new initiatives.

One of these new initiatives adopted firstly in year four and five, and now in year six and seven, is 'The Lexile Framework'. It is a reading system, aimed at enhancing our school literacy program (particularly in the upper school). This framework allows teachers to monitor the types of books your child is reading, their reading comprehension and the level of books that best suit your child's needs.



Our school resource centre is investing in collections of group readers, ranging in levels and areas of interest, and has also labeled books in our general collection (Fiction) with Lexile stickers.

Fortunately, the Lexile Framework is a web-based system, making it easily accessible to teachers. All students from **Year Four to Seven** receive a username and password, so they also have access via web to book/quiz searches, and can check if some of their favourite books have a Lexile level, at home. This tool can also be used to inform the types of books parents may wish to purchase for their child in the future.
